

AUTHORIZATION AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Please read carefully -

1. All statements made by me on this application are true and complete to the best of my knowledge and that I understand that misrepresentations or omissions may be cause for rejection, or may be cause for subsequent dismissal if hired.

In processing my application for employment, the Company may verify all the information provided by me including, but not limited to, my prior employment, education, character, general reputation, personal characteristics, credit history, and driving record.
